OPEN SHOWMANSHIP

No uncastrated male livestock over 1 year will be allowed in showmanship. Each handler must have a fair ID number. The top two showmen from each class will compete for champion. The top two from each species are eligible to compete in the open Round Robin Showmanship contest.
