

# General Equine Rules

**ENTRIES:** You must have an ID number issued by the Fair Office. Use this number when filling out your entry form. **Refer to Livestock Entry Rules at the beginning of Division 4.** You may also mail your entry to the Fair Office; send it attn: Equine Superintendent. Entries must be received by Saturday, July 31.

**STALL RESERVATIONS:** All exhibitors wishing to reserve stalls must have the following items turned into the Stall Manager on Entry Day, July 31, 1 – 6 p.m. You may also turn these items to the Fair Office prior to Entry Day.

- 1) Stall cards (one needed for each animal entered).
- 2) Copy of negative EIA (Coggins test). This will not be returned. The test must have been done within the current year.
- 3) \$20 deposit check per stall (no cash).

**Late Reservations will be charged \$10 per stall per day.** Stall check-in will be through the Stall Manager starting the evening of Thursday, August 5. The Stall Manager's hours will be posted on Entry Day.

Stalls may be reserved only for horses that are entered into Fairtime shows. Stalls are to be used **ONLY** by horses that are exhibited at the Fair during the time.

**PARKING:** Vehicle entry for the purpose of caring for or exhibiting horses will be made only through the Green Gate (see Fairground map). This area is for Livestock and Equine exhibitors only. Livestock/Equine Parking will be as follows: \$3 per day for day parking only (no overnight); \$5 per day for a 20' x 40' space; and \$7 per day for a 20' x 60' space. **Purchase of parking passes for exhibitors participating in Fair Halter can be arranged through the Show Manager. No parking passes will be sold through the Fair Office or at the gates.** Superintendents and Show Managers have reserved spaces. Failure to honor parking regulations will result in having your vehicle towed.

## SAFETY RULES:

1. Use of the arenas ends at 10:00 p.m.
2. Proper headgear and footgear are required.
3. No riding double.
4. Handle horse in a safe manner.
5. Safety and courtesy are required.
6. Animals must have proper care.
7. **Lead your horse outside arena areas.**
8. A midnight curfew will apply to the livestock buildings, barns, and parking areas.
9. Quiet hours of 11 p.m. to 7 a.m. must be observed.

## BARN AND STALL RULES:

1. No unauthorized motor vehicles in the arena or barns.
2. No smoking in barn or stall areas
3. No advertising posted on stalls
4. No personal padlocks on stalls
5. No storage or feed outside of stalls.
6. Do not leave horse in stall with tack on.
7. No dogs allowed in barns or stall areas.
8. Horses and equipment must be stalled in approved areas.
9. **STALLS ARE TO BE CLEANED EACH DAY**, and left clean when the horse goes home. Cleaning means picking out manure and wet shavings. Bedding does not have to be taken down to rock or sand except when a horse is checked out of the Fairgrounds.
10. Manure must be deposited in the designated area only.
