These rules have been developed for your safety. Your cooperation in making this event a success by reading and following these rules is greatly appreciated.

1. To participate, the parent or guardian of the child participant must complete and mail or bring an entry form to: **Special Events Coordinator, Tanana Valley State Fair, 1800 College Road, Fairbanks, Alaska 99709.**
2. Children must be in Sunrise Field Arena by 12:45 PM on the day of the event to participate.
3. Participants must be part of the *Orion's Belt School of Self Defense Summer Program*, or bring their own toy rockets to launch.
4. There will be two launch pads for participants to use to launch their rocket(s). At all times, there will be at least one adult supervising the launch of rockets on these pads.
5. Children are asked to assist in the retrieval of launched rockets throughout the event.
